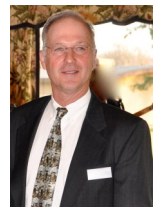

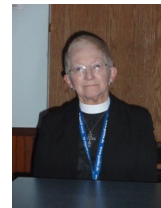
Moving? Changes in Information??

This is the beginning of National Safe Boating Week and Vessel Safety Checkers will be available to do inspections at this event. As part of Safe Boating Week, Saturday May 19, 2012 is Ready, Set, Wear It! Life Jacket World Record Day--so please Wear It. Maybe we can set a record for the number of people wearing life jackets to this event.

If you haven't had your vessel inspected yet and would like to do so before the Shakedown Cruise, contact P/C Connie Barry, JN and she will arrange for a checker to do your inspection.

Lt. William Kincannon, P reported on House Bill 1345 and 1307. Each of these bills would have greatly increased the cost of boating here in Maryland. Bill 1305 would have increased the tax up to 8% depending on the cost of the boat and bill 1307 would have increased the registration fee. Both of these bills failed to pass.

Get your summer white uniform ready as we have been asked to provide an honor guard for some Yacht Club openings--so far Red Eye Yacht Club and Baltimore Yacht Club.

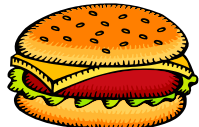
